Sealed proposals will be received at the Nemaha Natural Resources District Office, 62161 Highway 136, Tecumseh, NE 68450, until **4:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 12, 2025**, for shaping and riprap placement work on 3 Watershed Structures in Pawnee County (Bid A), Nebraska and 3 Watershed Structures in Johnson County (Bid B), Nebraska, and 2 Watershed Structures in Otoe County (Bid C), Nebraska.

Prospective bidders may assemble at the Long Branch P-8 site on 628 Ave ½ mile north of 718 RD about 5 miles Northeast of Table Rock at **8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, November 4, 2025**, for a group showing of the sites. We will start with the south sites in Pawnee County and work our way north ending with Wilson Creek 2-28 in Otoe County. In case of inclement weather, please contact the NRD office (402) 335-3325 for information.

The proposal shall be made on a form furnished by the NNRD.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish to the Nemaha Natural Resources District proof of insurance (\$1,000,000 minimum) within 15 days of Notice of Award.

Description of Work: Work involves the shaping and placement of Type B riprap on eroded faces of 3 Watershed Structures in Pawnee County, Nebraska and 3 Watershed Structures in Johnson County, Nebraska, and 2 Watershed Structures in Otoe County, Nebraska. Date of completion of project will be 60 calendar days after issuance of the Notice to Proceed. Weather days, as determined by the NRD, will be taken into account.

Notice: The Bid Schedule, Certification of Nonsegregated Facilities, Equal Opportunity Clause, Drug-Free Workplace Policy Clarification, and Federal Immigration Verification will be made part of the contract along with the proof of insurance.

1. The Bidder agrees to complete the work in 60 calendar days from Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages shall be assessed at the rate of \$300.00 for each day after 60 calendar days from Notice to Proceed. Weather days, as determined by the NRD, will be taken into account.
2. Payment will be made based on actual unit costs submitted, multiplied by actual quantities hauled. Any quantity above the estimate must receive approval from the Nemaha NRD.
3. The Nemaha NRD reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids submitted.
4. Contractor application for payment will be submitted to the NRD after final inspection of the work required according to the bid package.
5. Rock must be placed and packed with a track backhoe.
6. Bids will be taken on Part A consisting of 3 sites in Pawnee County, Part B consisting of 3 sites in Johnson County/Spring Creek, and Part C consisting of 2 sites in Otoe County. NNRD will award bids according to best options received.
7. Successful bidder will be required to furnish to the Nemaha Natural Resources District proof of insurance (\$1,000,000 minimum) to include workers compensation if applicable, within 15 days of Notice of Award.
8. **The Nemaha NRD is exempt from state sales tax.**
9. **This quote must be received in this office of the Nemaha NRD no later than 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 12, 2025. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope labeled "Dam Repair" and the name and address of the bidder on the front.**
