Tabled Permit Application N709: Wingert explained that because Nemaha County Rural Water District #2 had filed a "Notice of Intent" for a potential public water supply well, this would be considered a high capacity well that is within well permit spacing limits for application N709 submitted by Ryan Gobber. Therefore, Ryan Gobber withdrew his application for a permit. No action. b. New permit applications received were as follows:
