Conservation Tree Program

Each year, the Nemaha NRD supplies trees and shrubs to landowners across the district, supporting windbreaks, shelterbelts, wildlife habitat, and other conservation plantings.

Ordering

- \$1.50 per seedling, plus tax (sold in bundles of 25 per species)
- Self-planting orders due: March 13, 2026
- Pickup: Mid-April at the Nemaha NRD office

Machine Planting

- \$3.00 per tree, plus tax (minimum order of 200 seedlings)
- Orders are due by December 31, 2025
- Site preparation must be completed & certified by December 31, 2025

Notes

- Most seedlings come from the Bessey Nursery (Nebraska National Forest) and are about 2 years old.
- Species availability confirmed with payment; trees are not guaranteed.
- Keep roots moist, store in a cool, dark place, and plant promptly.



About the Nemaha NRD

The Nemaha NRD serves eight counties in southeast Nebraska. District boundaries follow the Nemaha River Basin watershed to reflect the region's land and water systems.

As one of 23 NRDs across the state, our mission is to protect natural resources and serve communities within our district.

Key priorities include flood and erosion control, water quality and quantity, forestry, soil conservation, and outdoor recreation. Programs range from tree planting and water monitoring to watershed protection and conservation partnerships.

The district is governed by a locally elected board of 21 directors and partners with landowners, communities, and agencies to conserve resources and improve quality of life across southeast Nebraska.
